

PARENTS/CARERS AND SPECTATORS

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

This code of conduct for Stamperland FC has been created to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.

Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

Play your part and observe Stamperland FC's Code of Conduct for parents/carers and spectators at all times.

I WILL:

- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- Always respect the decision of the match official.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators Area (where provided).
- Let the coach do their job and do not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials.
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning.

- Avoid placing undue pressure on players.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Never promote/support unsporting behaviour.
- Never approach/confront a referee, match official or coach.
- Not take photographs or videos during matches and training without prior and explicit permission of all concerned (club, opposition and officials).
- Inform any spectator I invite to watch my player of these codes of conduct and expected behaviours when spectating.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by Stamperland FC:

- Officially warned about my conduct by a club official.
- Required to meet with a club representative.
- Requested to leave the match venue by the club representative, referee or league representative.
- Requested by the club not to attend future games.
- Suspended or requested to leave the Club along with any dependants.
