## PARENT & SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT

The following code defines the fundamentals of good behaviour which is simply being courteous and respectful of everyone involved in the game. Being a good sport needs to be taught by example, encouraged at all time and taught at every opportunity and this can be achieved by following these simple rules:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Stay within the spectator's area of the rink
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Let the coaches do their job and do not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition and match officials
- Never criticise a player for making a mistake. Remember that mistakes are an important part of learning
- Pass on any concerns that you have about the wellbeing or welfare of a child to a club official
